

ADA Registration and Group Housing Convention 2010



Below please find detailed instructions on how you can reserve ADA hotel rooms in related group blocks for the 151st ADA Annual Session to be held October 9-13, 2010, in Orlando, FL. Electronic copies of the Preliminary Program may be downloaded at <http://www.ada.org/345.aspx>

The Alliance Hotel is The Peabody Orlando (#2 in the ADA Preliminary Program), 9801 International Drive, Orlando, FL 32819.

There are **three ways to register and secure hotel reservations – online, mail and fax**. A deposit of \$250 will be due for each hotel reservation, plus any applicable registration fee. Deposits and registration fees should be submitted online (credit card only), mailed (credit card or check) or faxed (credit card only) with each reservation to Experient for processing.

This block of rooms will be held until June 18, 2010, or until rooms are exhausted. After June 18 or once rooms are exhausted – whichever should occur first - rooms will be assigned on a space available basis at your assigned hotel or at a nearby hotel if space is not available at your assigned hotel. For this reason, we strongly encourage you to complete and return the reservation form as soon as possible.

Registration

Advance registration saves time and money, and ensures access to the largest number of ticketed courses. After September 10, all fees will increase and registration badge materials will not be mailed. To register for the Annual Session, please select the appropriate registration category and corresponding fee. You may also purchase tickets to courses, special events, or register friends and family. **Again this year, all courses, both fee and non-fee offerings will be ticketed.** To attend any course, you must present your ticket.

Advance registration for the Annual Session closes at 5:00pm Central Time on Friday, September 10, 2010. Registration, ticket and/or special event cancellations must be received in writing on or before September 10. Registration or ticket cancellations received by this date will receive a full refund, less a \$10 processing fee per cancellation. **No refunds will be given for registration cancellations received by Experient after September 10 for any reason.** Please allow 60 days for refund processing.

Housing

Hotel cancellations must be received in writing by Experient before 5:00 pm Central Time on Thursday, September 23, 2010. Cancellations received by this date will receive a full refund of the hotel deposit by Experient. Please allow 60 days for refund processing. Changes to reservations must be received in writing by Experient before 5:00 pm Central Time on Thursday, September 23, 2010. Failure to check-in to your hotel on the confirmed date of arrival will result in the forfeiture of the entire room deposit. As of Wednesday, September 29, 2010 any changes to hotel reservations must be made directly with the hotel. **Hotel deposit refunds will not be issued after September 23.**
