Begin with a drive through the **West Paces Ferry** area. This exclusive residential area, also known as the **Beverly Hills of the South**, is also home to some America's most famous residents: **Bernie Marcus and Arthur Blank**, co-founders of Home Depot.

Next, explore Atlanta's colorful past in further detail at the **Atlanta History Center**. The Atlanta History Center's award-winning exhibitions will illuminate Atlanta's history from the Civil War to Civil Rights and beyond with incredible stories, artifacts and models.

Take this opportunity also to stroll through the **Tullie Smith House and Farm**. A plantation-plain house built in the 1840s by the Robert Smith family; the Tullie Smith House is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Your third stop in the grounds of the Atlanta History Center will be a tour of the elegant 1928 **Swan House Mansion**. You will learn about the prior occupants of this splendid home and view some unique design features used in its architecture.

The **Swan Coach House**, once serving as the garage and servants' quarters for Swan House, now houses a delightful restaurant and gift shop. Within this atmosphere of traditional Southern elegance you may enjoy regional cuisine and tearoom specialties, shop for unique gifts and view a changing collection of exciting contemporary southern art.
