AADA Conference Speakers



Dr. Chris Bulnes was born and raised in Tampa. He attended the University of South Florida to attain his undergraduate degree in Chemistry. He then earned his DMD Degree from Southern Illinois University in 2000 and his Advanced Education in General Dentistry in 2001 from Southern Illinois University. Dr. Bulnes has practiced general dentistry in Tampa since 2001. Dr. Bulnes has been President of several dental organizations throughout his career, giving back to the profession of dentistry. He served as President of the Hillsborough County Dental Association and the West Coast District Dental Association. He is a Trustee to the Florida Dental Association and served Florida as their representative to the Council on Dental Benefits and Programs at the American Dental Association headquartered in Chicago, IL. He presently serves as the state-wide Co-Chair for the FDAF's Mission of Mercy which is a free clinic that produces between \$1.7– \$2.9 million of free dental care over a 2-day period. Dr. Bulnes resides in Tampa, FL with his wife Kelsey and their three children.

Ms. Bailey Parker started her communications career at KSTU FOX 13 in Salt Lake City, Utah in 2012 as a producer, reporter and fill-in anchor. She made the jump to public relations in 2015 as a communications specialist with Dixie Regional Medical Center in St. George, Utah. She won six public relations related awards while at DRMC.

Ms. Parker recently moved to Columbia, SC for her husband to attend graduate school at the University of South Carolina. She is a graduate from Utah State University with degrees in Journalism & Communications and Creative Writing. She is originally from Glastonbury, CT.



Dr. Tese Stephens, an Associate Professor at the Medical University of South Carolina, has been exploring the concept of RESILIENCE for over a decade, specifically related to nurses and other clinicians. She is the author of Stephens' Model of Resilience and the P.R.E.P. Program (Personal Resilience Enhancement Plan). Her work with clinicians, combat veterans, and Holocaust survivors has led to her current role as a consultant for the South Carolina Hospital Association's efforts in Fighting Burnout in clinicians at a state level, funded by a grant from the Duke Endowment Organization. Dr. Stephens will be presenting some of her work, including the tools and strategies used in the P.R.E.P. Program for participants to utilize in their own efforts to increase personal resilience.

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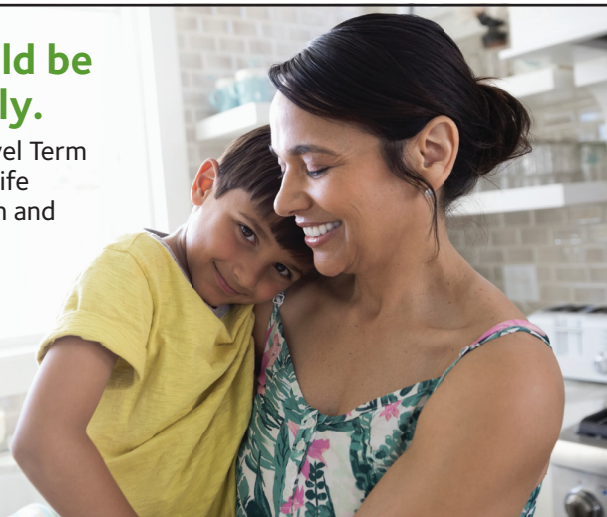
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
